AGENDA WORDING:

An ordinance relating to boundaries of neighborhood councils.

BACKGROUND:

Section 73 of the City Charter and SMC 4.27.010 provide that initial boundaries of neighborhood councils shall remain fixed for a one year period upon recognition by the City Council and that geographical boundaries of neighborhood councils may extend to areas beyond the city limits. The Hillyard Neighborhood Council, the Moran Prairie Neighborhood Council, the Thorpe-Westwood Neighborhood Council and the Five Mile Neighborhood Council all have geographical boundaries that extend beyond the city limits. The inclusion of unincorporated areas in these four neighborhood councils has hindered the efforts of City residents, property owners and business owners located in the respective neighborhood council in communicating their goals and objectives to other neighborhood councils, the Community Assembly, the City Council, and other governmental agencies. This ordinance will modify the boundaries of these four neighborhood councils by removing those portions of the neighborhood councils extending beyond the city limits until such time as the City Council takes legislative action to further modify the boundaries.
